VANĀ SOM (meaning a peaceful place in the woods) reflects the heritage and traditions of Northern Thailand from the golden teak pillars to the true taste of the region, from the temple tours to the lure of nature in mountains, forest, and hill-tribe communities. This jewel of a residence is a classic Siamese-Lanna country manor consisting of several pavilions dating back in some places to the 13th century.

Just 16km from the ancient capital of Chiang Mai, it is a gateway to the treasures of Northern Thailand. An imposing example of Lanna architecture, the residence is filled with antiques and artefacts, including a fine collection of Sukhothai and pre-Lanna porcelain as well as Buddhas from different periods while offering every contemporary comfort.

Originally a family's winter retreat, designed by the country's award-winning architect, it is both luxurious and cosy. The seven en-suite accommodations are on three separate floors and an out-house pavilion: The Upper House, The Middle House, The Lower House, and The Sala. The outbuildings are dining, relaxing spaces and a meditation area.

LOCATION:

16km northwest of Chiangmai in scenic Maerim
District. The property is located in one of the most
desirable locations of Chiangmai being in a tranquil
setting surrounded by peaceful nature and endless
choice for outdoor recreations and attractions while
conveniently close to the city center.

ACCOMMODATION:

Four units: 1 bedroom, 2 bedrooms, 3 bedrooms on separate floors of the villa; 1-bedroom studio in a separate building.

FACILITIES:

Full-resort service with butlers, housekeeping, back and front-of-house staff; wifi, premium amenities, in-room dining, restaurant, hi-tea, sundowners, full-service bar, chefs, a car with driver, massage, spa, yoga, bicycles, and other activities; access to the gym and pool facility at Four Seasons Resort Chiangmai (subject to availability).





THE UPPER HOUSE

2 CONNECTING SUITES WITH 1 SUPER-KING AND 1 SUPER-QUEEN BED, 1 BATH WITH SEPARATE SHOWER, 120SQM; LARGE LIVING AREA AT BALCONY, PRIVATE-TEMPLE PAVILLION

TThe Master Suite, The Rose of the North (120sqm), houses a separate living area as well as a balcony. The master bathroom is a state of the art where the bay window commands the treetop view of the forest. The Suite has an extra bed (Super Queen sized bed).

Up the spiral staircase to the very top of the building is the secret jewel of the entire estate - a family temple with an impressive collection of Buddha statues from different periods. A perfect spot for meditation and reading.


















THE MIDDLE HOUSE

1 SUITE WITH SUPER-KING BED, 1 BATH WITH SEPERATE SHOWER, 80SQM, LIVING & DINING

The middle floor houses
The Hollyhock room
(80sqm) with the best view
of the forest. The suite has
en-suite bath and shower,
walk-in dressing area and
lounge.

The indoor kitchen, dining room, formal living hall, and lounge overlooking the forest are located on this floor.















THE LOWER HOUSE


3 SUITES WITH 2 SUPER KING AND 1 SUPER QUEEN BEDS, 2 BATHS, 2 SHOWERS, 1 GUEST TOILET, LIVING, DINING AND KITCHEN PANTRY; 220SQM, WITH DIRECT ACCESS TO GARDEN

There are three bedrooms on this floor: the Master Suite (85sqm - Cleome) is connected to, and share the master bathroom with, Cosmos (35sqm) - ideal for a family.

A separate suite is The Hidden Lily room (50sqm) with windows open to the forest.


The Lower House has living and family area, with direct access to the garden.
























THE SALA








THE GARDENS

THE BAR

Set in a greenhouse, with recycled teakwood and terra-cotta floor finishes, the bar interior is fitted with antiques including an 1890 bar counter. The bar is surrounded by floral and manicured lawn. Much of the culinary herbs are used in the house's cocktails.

The Farmers' Bar serves a selection of wines, cocktails, coffee, and other non-alcoholic drinks. Tapasstyle food, farm produce and homemade delicatessen are also available from 11 am till late every day.


















THE RESTAURANT

THE EXPERIENCE

There are elephant sanctuaries to visit as well as the tribal villages which surround the Golden Triangle. Best of all, the staff at Vana Som are locals from the Lanna, Thai Yai and Karen tribe whose knowledge of the area is unsurpassed. It is this indigenous aspect that makes a stay so memorable.

And then, of course, Chiang Mai is the old cultural capital which showcases not just the Lanna architecture in its palaces and temples – visit the Old Quarter and take a temple safari among more than 100 such buildings – but also textiles, porcelain, wood carving, and silver.
